Feng Shui Series

THE PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS OF COLOR are well known. Not only can it make a room seem larger or smaller, warmer or cooler but color can also make a room cheerful or depressing.

In feng shui, the compass points have particular colors associated with them. Ideally, the main area in a room should complement the direction it faces. You don't have to use the color in its primary state – you can use tones that are more suited to your personal taste and the particular space.

If, for instance, your bedroom faces east it will catch the warm morning sun no matter what the color of the room. At night, you will want the room to be restful so use blue/green colors of the east, also associated with the element wood.

If you find that you don't like the color associated with a particular orientation you can always choose a neutral for the walls and use the feng shui color as accents in soft furnishings or ornaments. Black accents, for example, combine with natural tones.

Color can also be used as a remedy in feng shui when you aren't physically able to change the layout of a room. For instance, to make the qi flow more slowly in a study you should use quiet colors like cool blues and greens.

Rooms facing north in the northern hemisphere and south in the southern hemisphere will be cool and will benefit from the yang of warm reds; while the south in the northern hemisphere and the north in the southern hemisphere will be warm and are best in cool yin blues and greens.
